Here is a summary of the discussion points from the Jan 17th meeting:

- ◆ Current membership is at 95 people
- ◆ Prices for firing will need to go up, now will be \$1.00 per kg, and over 1000 degrees will be \$2.00 per kg
- ◆ Ellen has put in requests for signage permission for our 2019 Art Show to Banyule council
- ◆ Peter will continue to seek out opportunities for DVAS artists to display work
- ◆ MI Flower and Garden Show, submissions need to be properly framed, D ring wired and in appropriate labelled carry bags, it was very messy and rushed during pack up last year. Discussion about price rise for submissions. Will also put in new process for checkoff at the end of each day of show to keep track of paintings and sales. Importance of every one submitting work being part of sitting roster.

Julian Opie exhibition at NGV

The exhibition at the NGV runs from November 2018 to 17th Feb 2019. His work is very simplistic and bold in colour. 


